NLE02 The English Narrow Gauge - Historic Drawings (Ray Tustin) £6.00

Covering the Ashover, Leek & Manifold and Lynton & Barnstaple Railways.

NLE03 Scrapbook of Narrow Gauge Drawings (Geoff Thorne) £6.00

A wide variety of subjects including Bagnall, Decauville, Sentinel and Hanomag engines, and the Glyn Valley, Clogher Valley, County Donegal and Kelani Valley (Sri Lanka) Railways.

NLE04 Narrow Gauge Drawings - Reprinted from Early Issues of Narrow Lines £6.00

A further wide variety including the Festiniog and North Wales Narrow Gauge railways, a range of brake vans and Baldwin, Kerr Stuart, Manning Wardle and Dick Kerr locomotives.

NLE05 Welsh Highland Railway (Locomotive and Rolling Stock Drawings) £6.00

Produced in collaboration with Keith Millard and the Welsh Highland Heritage Railway, this covers the locomotives and rolling stock of the original North Wales Narrow Gauge Railways and the Heritage Railway but not the reopened through operation.

NLE06 The Irish Narrow Gauge (Scale Drawings by David Lloyd) £7.00

This publication was originally edited by Howard Piltz and produced in co-operation with the publishers of Railway Modeller magazine. The first part is descriptive with photos, the second providing drawings of many locomotives and railcars, with an emphasis on the County Donegal.

NLE08 The Festiniog Railway (Historic Drawings: Locomotives & Rolling Stock) £8.00

Published in collaboration with the Festiniog Railway Company. The first half of this publication presents historic data, with some photographs, on locomotives and rolling stock of the pre-preservation era which are then shown in the drawings in the second half.

NLE09 Buildings & Structures (Scale Drawings) £6.00

A collection of buildings and structures drawn from a wide range of narrow gauge railways around the British Isles. Notes are included against each of the drawings giving background details.

NLE10 Another Selection of Drawings - Reprinted from Narrow Lines £6.00

A further wide selection of motive power drawings from the Padarn, Isle of Man, Tasmanian Government, Geldersche (NL), Southwold, Malta, Gentle Annie (NZ) and Groudle Glen Railways and Tramways, amongst other subjects.

An extensive range of drawings of motive power and rolling stock from both the 3' and 15" gauge eras.
